ANSWER KEY AND GRAMMAR ANALYSIS

25 She **WAS TO BLAME FOR** losing the basketball match.

Remember to put the verb 'be' in past and include 'for' in the sentence.

26 They **ARE LIKELY TO** win the match.

In this structure you must use: BE + LIKELY TO + VERB.

27 The I.T. department **MANAGED TO FIX** Jane's laptop.

Succeed in doing something is the same as manage to do something.

Don't confuse gerund and infinitive constructions.

28 Would **YOU MIND CLOSING** the window, please?

Here, you are being tested on verbs followed by gerund.

*You **MUST** know the most common ones such as: like, love, hate, enjoy, mind, etc...*

29 Janet **CAN NOT/COULD NOT (CANNOT / CAN'T) HAVE BEEN** in the pub last night.

*You **MUST** know the correct verb participles (especially irregular verbs), so study them!*

30 It's **NOT WORTH BUYING (IT)** as you can download it for free.

Worth and not worth are always followed by gerund.
